1. Our structure

2. Our business

We are a B2B SaaS company, selling social analytics and data visualisation software to enterprise customers. You can find out more about our business at www.wordnerds.ai

3. Our supply chain

Our supply chain for our core business consists of primarily data providers (such as X) and data centre/cloud service providers (such as Amazon Web Services and Google Cloud). We also use a number of SaaS companies as ancillary service providers, such as Hubspot.

4. Slavery and human trafficking

We continue to operate our business to maintain our success in avoiding any human trafficking in our supply chain.
